NI Protocol: Movements of Bees from GB to NI

Movement of Queens only GB Trader (or Beekeeper) reviews movement requirements Trader (or Beekeeper) notifies the National Bee Unit with advance notice of intended movement from GB to NI and applies for Export Health Certificate (EHC) Trader (or Beekeeper) arranges with the NBU for consignment to inspected, NBU/authorised signatory issues EHC following inspection.

Consignment subject to document check and may also be subject to inspection

Consignment leaves
GB with EHC and
transits through to NI
Designated Point of
Entry

Trader or NI Importer notifies NI Designated Point of Entry of consignment (and should also check how much notice needs to be given)

And NI Importer submits pre-notification on TRACES at least 24hrs prior to arrival of queen bees

From 1 January 2021 a Trader will need an EORI number that starts with XI for any necessary customs declarations to:

- move goods between Northern Ireland and non-EU countries
- make a declaration in Northern Ireland
- get a customs decision in Northern Ireland
